- It shall not be a violation of this injunction for defendants to seek and obtain legal advice from their attorneys.
- Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d), this injunction shall bind 5. the defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, successors, and attorneys, and those persons in active concert or participation with them who receive notice of the order by personal service or otherwise.
