- 1 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that OAKLAND CANNABIS BUYERS' COOPERATIVE
- 2 and JEFFERY JONES, Defendants in the above-styled action, hereby appeal to the United States
- 3 Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit from the final judgment of the district court. This Court
- 4 previously entered final judgment by granting summary judgment and entering a permanent
- 5 injunction against Defendants in two separate orders dated May 3, 2002 and June 10, 2002,
- 6 respectively. Because these orders did not dispose of the claims of the interveners, this Court entered
- 7 its July 29, 2002 Order Granting Defendants' Motion for Partial Judgment pursuant to Federal Rule
- 8 of Civil Procedure 54(b). On August 1, 2002, Defendants appealed this Court's orders to the United
- 9 States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. After fully briefing the appeal on the merits, on June
- 10 18, 2004, the Ninth Circuit issued an order remanding Defendants' appeal to this Court for
- 11 reconsideration following the United States Supreme Court's decision in the related case of Gonzales
- 12 v. Raich, __ U.S. __, 125 S. Ct. 2195 (2005). In an order dated June 6, 2005, this Court declined to
- 13 reconsider its prior rulings in light of the Supreme Court's opinion in Raich, which constituted final
- 14 judgment after remand. In addition to final judgment, Defendants also appeal all interlocutory orders
