NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that MARIN ALLIANCE FOR MEDICAL MARIJUANA and LYNETTE SHAW, D.C., Defendants in the above-styled action, hereby appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit from the final judgment of the District Court. This Court previously entered final judgment by granting summary judgment and entering a permanent injunction against Defendants in two separate orders dated May 3, 2002 and June 10, 2002, respectively. Because these Orders did not dispose of the claims of the intervenors, this Court entered its July 29, 2002 Order Granting Defendants' Motion for Partial Judgment pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b).

In an Order dated June 6, 2005, this Court declined to reconsider its prior rulings in light of the Supreme Court's opinion in Raich, which constituted final judgment after remand. In addition to final judgment, Defendants also appeal all interlocutory orders that gave rise to that judgment, including but not limited to:

- May 19, 1998 Order denying Defendants' Motion to Dismiss;
- May 19, 1998 Order;
