NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that UKIAH CANNABIS BUYER'S CLUB, CHERRIE LOVETT, MARVIN LEHRMAN and MILDRED LEHRMAN, Defendants in the above-styled action, hereby appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit from the final judgment of the district court. This matter is a related case to Nos. C-98-00088 CRB and C-98-00086 CRB. This Court previously entered final judgment by granting summary judgment and entering a permanent injunction against Defendants in two separate orders dated May 3, 2002 and June 10, 2002, respectively. Because these orders did not dispose of the claims of the interveners, this Court entered its July 29, 2002 Order Granting Defendants' Motion for Partial Judgment pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b). On August 1, 2002, Defendants appealed this Court's orders to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. After fully briefing the appeal on the merits, on June 18, 2004,

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the Ninth Circuit issued an order remanding Defendants' appeal to this Court for reconsideration following the United States Supreme Court's decision in the related case of *Gonzales v. Raich*, \_\_\_\_\_ U.S. \_\_\_\_, 125 S.Ct. 2195 (2005). In an order dated June 6, 2005, this Court declined to reconsider its prior rulings in light of the Supreme Court's opinion in *Raich*, which constituted final judgment after remand. In addition to final judgment, Defendants also appeal all interlocutory orders that gave rise to that judgment, including but not limited to:

- May 19, 1998 Order Denying Defendants' Motion to Dismiss;
