ORDER


Appellants' motion for an extension of time to file opening brief is construed as a motion stay appellate proceedings pending disposition of *Raich v. Gonzales*, no. 03-15481. So construed, the motion is granted in part.

These cases are stayed until April 14, 2006. On or before the expiration of the stay, appellants may move for further appropriate relief. In the absence of a motion from the appellants, the stay will expire and the opening brief will be due April 14, 2006. If the opening brief is filed, answering brief shall be due May 15, 2006; and the optional reply brief shall be due 14 days after service of the answering brief.

The filing of the opening brief or failure to move for appropriate relief shall terminate the stay.
